

Terms and conditions for use of the IP Inclusive logo by Charter signatories.

Use by anyone else is strictly forbidden without prior consent.

IP Inclusive encourages Charter signatories to use the logo and other branding to promote equality, diversity and inclusion in IP. The following guidelines apply:

1. All intellectual property rights in the logo are owned by and remain in the ownership of IP Inclusive.
2. The organisation must be signed up to IP Inclusive's Charter for Equality, Diversity and Inclusion.
3. If the organisation ceases to meet the criteria for remaining a signatory to the Charter, the organisation must cease all use of the logo within one month, insofar as is practicable.
4. The logo must not be used by the organisation to imply that an event, activity or publication is endorsed by IP Inclusive without prior consent.
5. IP Inclusive reserves the right to challenge any use of the logo which falls outside of the spirit of the Charter for Equality, Diversity and Inclusion or which it believes may be in breach of these guidelines.
