Caring in the UK

Every day, 12,000 people become unpaid carers for a partner, family member or a friend.

There are **5.8 million unpaid carers** in the UK.

59% of unpaid carers are female.

The biggest proportion of carers are aged 55-59 and therefore likely to still be in full time employment.



Carers Rights Day

Most unpaid carers are "accidental" carers and many don't think of themselves as carers.

As a result, they are often unaware of their legal rights and what they're entitled to in terms of benefits.
